Dear Parents and Carers,

Following careful consideration and discussion with the Chair of Governors, and with the already high temperatures expected to rise further, I have made the difficult decision to close the school tomorrow, Thursday 25th June 2026.

The wellbeing and safety of our pupils and staff must remain our priority.

Weather forecasts indicate that temperatures are expected to reach around 30°C this evening and are not expected to fall below 23°C overnight. Temperatures are expected to be 3°C hotter tomorrow.

Our school building is not designed to safely accommodate these exceptionally high temperatures, particularly after several days of extreme heat, and with predicted overnight temperatures not expected to fall below 23°C, the classrooms will have no opportunity to cool down overnight.

We appreciate that this decision may cause inconvenience, and we have not taken it lightly. However, we believe it is the most responsible course of action given the expected conditions and the peak of temperatures still to come.

The good news is that temperatures will return to more manageable levels on Friday, around 23°C, and we look forward to welcoming everyone back to school then.
